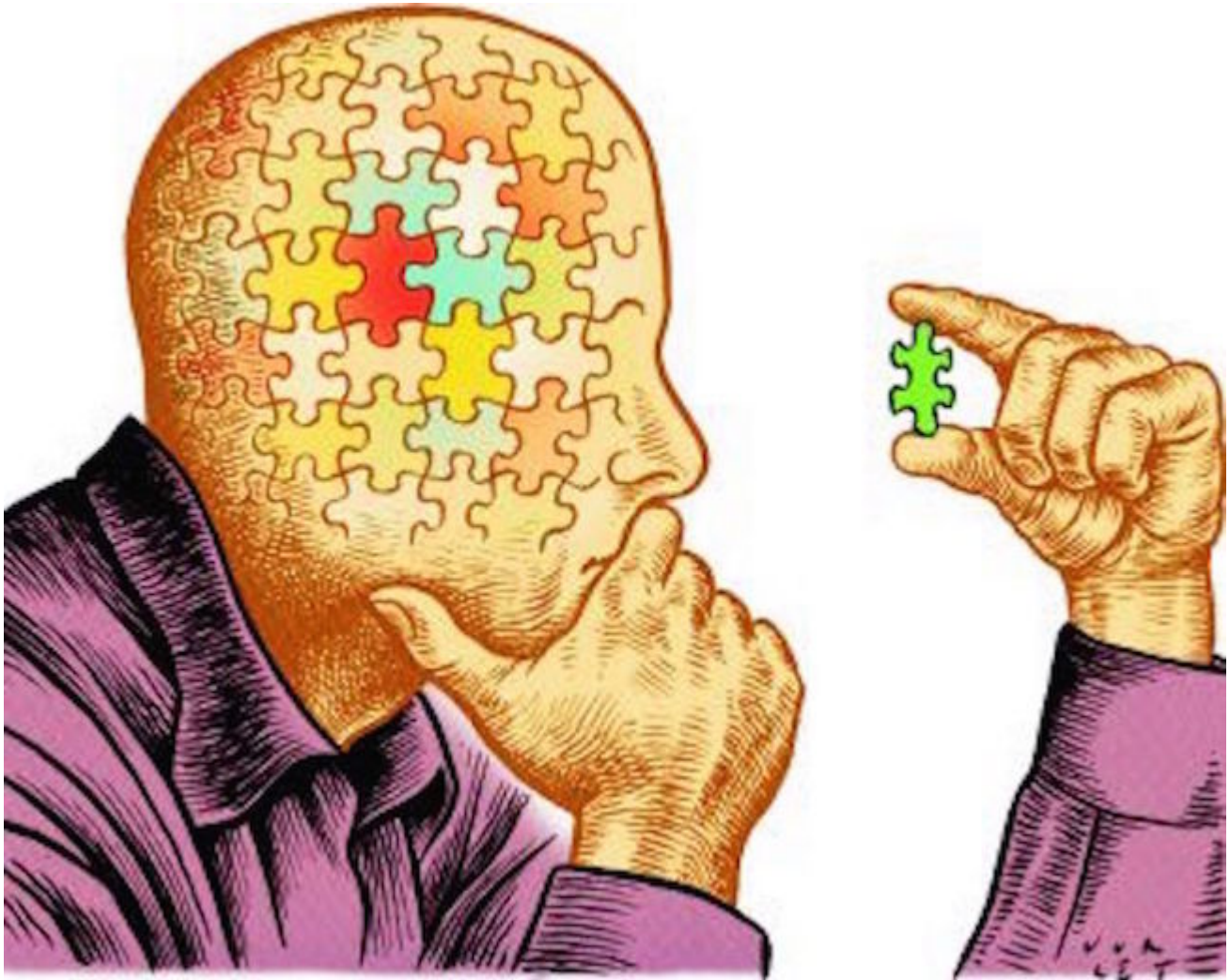


Theodor W. Adorno: Resignation
